- And we learned how to fold a lot of cardboard boxes.



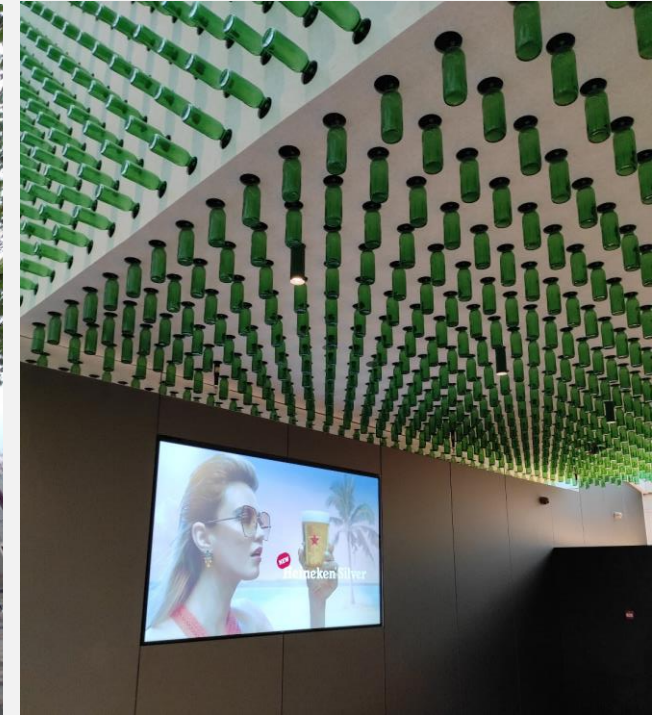
3 DAYS OF SCHOOL
